

予定される投稿規定

新しい会誌“Entomological Science”の発行が決定されたのを受け、将来問題検討委員会より、編集委員会に新会誌の投稿規定の作製が付託された。これにもとづき現・次期編集委員長で草案を作製し、紙面編集委員会により検討を加えた。“Entomological Science”の投稿規定は、凡そ以下に示すようなものとなる。

Notice to Contributors

“Entomological Science” is published by the Entomological Society of Japan as the successor of the **Japanese Journal of Entomology**. “Entomological Science” publishes (1) Original Papers and (2) Reviews of any field of the entomology and its allied field. Only articles written in English will be considered.

Reviews and original papers submitted to “Entomological Science” should not have been published or accepted elsewhere. Reviews are usually invited by the Editor. Original papers of no more than 15 published pages and Contributed reviews will be published free for member author(s). Charges will be made for extra pages (12,000 yen/page). Fifty reprints are provided free for member authors. All contributed papers and reviews are reviewed by at least two referees. Papers submitted from non-members are welcome, but will be charged (for the moment 2,000 yen/page for first 15 published pages and 12,000 yen for each extra page).

Manuscript

Authors should submit three printed copies, including a full set of figures, for each to the Editor at the address below. If halftone photographs are not reproduced well by photocopy, then photographs equivalent to original copies should be attached. Disk and original figures should not be sent until the paper is accepted. Manuscripts must be printed on one side of A 4-size paper with more than 12 pt font size and double spaced throughout including references and figure captions, with a left margin more than 3 cm. Words to be italicized may be indicated in italic font or underlined. Avoid capitalization in all cases except abbreviations for depositories and technical terms. After acceptance of a paper, authors are required to send a disk on which the manuscripts are saved as a Windows, IBM or Macintosh formatted text file in accordance with the instructions mentioned below. At this time original figures should also be sent.

Text preparation

For printed manuscripts, a cover page should provide the title of the paper, names of the authors, full postal addresses to which the editor can contact, including telephone numbers, FAX numbers and e-mail addresses if possible, a proposal of a running title and number of reprints required. The second page starts with the title of the paper, followed by names of
