

# 畠山文庫目録

## はじめに

ここに紹介する畠山文庫は、明治8年3月から翌9年10月まで、東京書籍館(帝国図書館の前身)館長の職にあった畠山義成の旧蔵本である。明治10年1月、実兄二階堂蓐氏の「従前所蔵之洋籍若干有之候ニ付、貴館ニ納メ普ク稠人ニ縦覧、該博之一助ニモ相成候ハハ、本人遺念モ相達シ、靈魂モ満足可致」との意を受けて、東京書籍館に「献納」、帝国図書館を経て今日の当館に至った。正に、西南戦争の余波で廃館決定(明治10年2月4日)の一月前のことであった。

「献納」時の「別紙目録」は散逸のため、詳細は不明であるが、「東京書籍館明治十年報」で見ると、「英吉利書」888冊、「仏蘭西書」19冊、「独乙書」11冊、「伊太利書」1冊の計919冊となっている(この時単価3円の計算で、代価計2,757円を支払った模様である)。但し現在確認できた図書は273部380冊に過ぎない。この差は調査漏れの外、合冊製本や、重複本の中、教科書的なものは中学、専門学校(旧制)等へ恵贈したり、図書区分の甲乙設定の際、乙部資料として一部廃棄処分になったこと、などによるものか。残存図書はいずれも標題紙に、「明治十年納付」の朱印と、「故東京書籍館長畠山義成遺

書」の押印がある。彼自身の署名本も相当数ある。ロンドン留学時は一般に K.Z. Soogiwoola の次に日付 (no. 45 の例 July 20th 1867)。米国留学時は K.Z. Soogiwoora/Rutger's College/New Brunswick/N.J., それに日付と縦書きで「杉浦弘蔵」のサインがある。もっとも中には再製本の際、署名部分がカットされた形跡の図書もある。

ところで畠山義成は日向の名族畠山氏の出で、1842年10月鹿児島に生まれた。65年4月薩藩留學生の一人として、「杉浦弘蔵」の変名(英米留学時はこの名が一般的)で、森有礼、鯨島尚信らと共に英国に留学 (University College, London), 更に67年夏米国に転じ、翌年春ニュージャージー州ニュー・ブルンズウィックのラトガース・カレッジに入学、4年後の71年(明治4年)卒業する。翌年3月「岩倉使節団」に書記官として米国で合流、『米欧回覧実記』の編者久米邦武と共に重要な役割を果たした。73年帰国後文部省に出仕、併せて開成学校長や東京書籍館長の職にあり、76年米国フィラデルフィア万国博覧会へ出張、帰途病没した。

次に畠山文庫本を出版地、主題で分類したのが次ページの表である。

これで見ると、歴史・地理が最も多く、語学・文学がこれに次ぐこと、米書中に占める宗教関係書の比重の高さが注目される。前者は、英米留学時代の古典語学習と、政治史を含めた歴史研究を反映するものと言えよう。後者は、渡米の契機となった新生社運動の実践者トーマス・ハリス (Thomas Lake Harris, 1823-1906) との関わりと、キリスト教徒としてのその後の畠山の関心と交遊関係を示すものとして興味深い。なお英書、米書とも、留学期を中心とし、これに岩倉使節団時代の収書を加えたものとなっており、特に後者は『米欧回覧実記』の記事とも当然のことながら符合する。久米が

岩倉大使の記録係とすれば、畠山は大使の通訳として得意の英語力を駆使したようで、欧州訪問に際しての英文の各国案内書など猛勉強が良く窺える。

なお本目録は西村正守氏 (現専門調査員) の調査を基に、それ以後の調査結果を追加しまとめたものである。今後新たな発見があれば、追加分として本誌に掲載する予定である。
